FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How Do I Register?

Register either through our website www.lynnacademy.com, the Mail or on our depicted in person registration days. Please complete the registration form and submit along with the registration fee & tuition. Registration cannot be accepted via, e-mail or phone. Once registration & tuition is received, you will be sent a confirmation e-mail. Please bring the confirmation to the first week of classes. You can pay fees by credit card, cash, or check made payable to the LYNN Academy of ID.

How Long Does it Take to Learn?

While watching in awe at a dance school performance, a parent may wonder, "how long does it take for my child to learn those amazing steps?" This all depends on the dancer's age, talents, commitment, home practice, etc. Every dancer is different & can progress at his or her own pace.

What Kinds of Events Are Held Throughout The Year

The dancers have the opportunity to perform throughout the year at festivals, St. Patrick's Day parades in Morristown & Somerville NJ parades, shows, and for family and friends at our end of the year recital.

Do I need a Costume?

No, the first year dancers only need to wear their LYNN Academy shorts and a white blouse to dance at events throughout the year. For dancing in parades, a wind suit will need to be purchased due to possible inclement weather conditions. Most dancers do not purchase a costume until their third year of Irish.

How Do I Know What's Going On?

E-mails will be sent on a regular basis notifying families of events throughout the year, so please ensure that your e-mail address is correct!

Should My Dancer Perform At a local Feis My First Year?

Yes!, The beginner Irish dancers are welcome to take their time, have fun & to see what Irish dancing is all about. However, an instructor will notify the dancer via e-mail when she thinks that he or she is ready to perform in a Feis. Since most of the beginners by the end of the year know their light jig and/or reel, our Feis in Atlantic City, NJ is a really fun event.

Maureen J. Collins, TCRG and director of the LYNN Academy Audubon location is a certified Irish dance teacher with the Commission in Ireland. Maureen is a two time 1st place North American Irish dance champion and has won 1st place in the Eastern & Southern Region championships. Choosing a Class.....

For those of you registering for the first time, here are some guidelines to assist you in choosing the right class. We do know that there's always the occasional exception to the rule, so we appreciate in advance your patience during the first few weeks of class while we make sure that your dancer is in the right place.

Tiny Tot: Introduction to Irish Dancing, learning counting to music, coordination, balance, and jumping

Level 1 Beginner: Introduction to Irish dancing learning rhythm, counting to music, balance, coordination, basics, light jig and reel.

Level 2 Advanced Beginner: Second Year of Irish dancing. Introduction to hard shoe learning the treble jig and hornpipe in addition to the reel, light jig, and slip jig.

Level 3 Novice: Dancers competing at the Novice level at local Feisanna or dancers in their 3rd year or more of Irish dancing

Level 4-6 PW—Championships Dancers in the PW to Championship level or dancing the equivalent number of years.
